The year 2005 has been a unique year for the ministry in that Elaine was seconded to Elim Christian Centre for the first six months of the year, to join the leadership in Pastoring the church until the arrival of the new Pastor, Jason Heron and his family. The role of Pastoring was an honour, very challenging, inspiring and edifying we hope, to both the fellowship and Elaine, as she brought teaching and preaching each week to the congregation, together with leadership and pastoral care to the Church members.

The role was not a visionary position to bring new direction, rather a bridging time of one ministry to another to bring and maintain stability in the interim period. Ministry Equipping School - Royal Mandate Ministries scheduled four Schools bringing teaching to 38 students across four schools in Northampton, Warwick and Hertfordshire, where enthusiastic people met weekly to receive powerful impartation for the work of God.

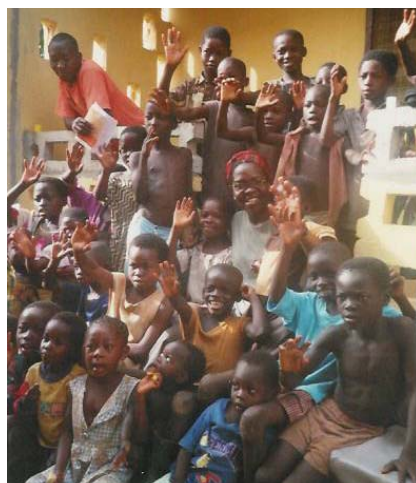

Feed the Poor

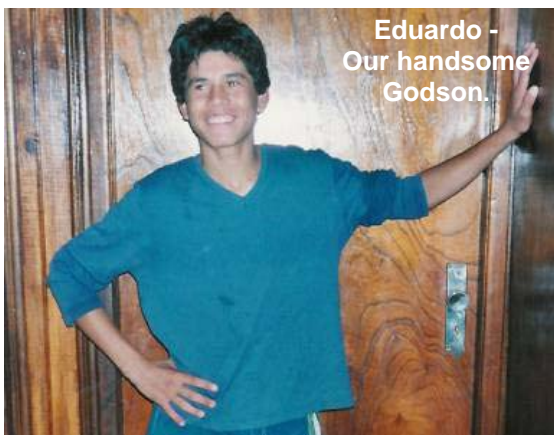
Charlottes Children – The Home of Charlottes Children is an orphanage in Jamaica that homes 15 abandoned and orphaned children. Royal Mandate Ministries support these children through paying for their entire school uniform and extra school kit including text and exercise books.

Ghana - Peter Roberts led a team back to Ananekrom to complete the school building that we started in 2004. Upon completion the school was handed over to the community in a handing over ceremony. The school has served as a catalyst for World Vision to now build other community projects around the vicinity of the school and is now being used by 200 local children. Gifts of books, pens, and other portable equipment were taken out, as well as children fitted out with school uniforms for the year.



Maputaland – South Africa - Royal Mandate Ministries supports this growing and developing church plant where the Royal Mandate Ministries team preached in crusades and seminars, seeing many souls added to the church. The greatest need here is for materials to bring Biblical discipleship to the new converts.

Israel – Royal Mandate Ministries supports the returnees to Israel. All unsold clothing from the shop and good quality small household items are sent to Israel to help all those who are going back to Israel who have nothing but the clothes that they stand up in.



Paraguay – Royal Mandate Ministries assists the orphanage 'Che Roga' in Encarnacion, Paraguay, serving 62 homeless street children. Most of the children are saved and baptised in the Holy Spirit. The Orphanage has planted its own church and fast food 'take-away' to bring employment to the older children and evangelise the local area. We also support a fine young man Eduardo and help pay for his education, healthcare, food and clothes as well as pray for him.

South Africa – Royal Mandate Ministries has committed to long term support of Tumelo Homes. An AIDs orphanage. The children here are mostly AIDs infected and many have severe physical disabilities. Our funding helps to feed, clothe and provide medical care for the children throughout the year. At times our support has enabled children that die to be buried with dignity.
