In April at the Elim National Conference, Elaine was ordained into Elim Pentecostal Churches UK. This is the recognition of Elaine in the ministry of an evangelist by Elim. She will continue to minister across all the streams of the Church of Jesus Christ as she has done for a number of years.

It was a God honouring occasion and many of Elaine's family and friends were there to witness it.

Elaine will continue to serve the Lord full time as Evangelist and Director for World Mandate Ministries preaching the Gospel, training and releasing the Saints and feeding the poor.

Whilst at the conference Elaine was invited to speak at one of the healing seminars. Many, many people were healed. One lady had had ME for over thirty years and for the past four years had been mainly confined to a wheelchair. PRAISE GOD after prayer she pushed the wheelchair back to her chalet, attended the evening celebration meeting and danced before God. She is making up for lost time and is now involved in youth work in her local church. This is only one of many accounts of miraculous healings for which we give God all the Glory, He truly is an awesome God. Another lady was healed from twenty-five years of "chronic migraine" requiring regular morphine injections for pain relief. God instantly healed her and she remains pain free.

The next day people came to our exhibition stand and we prayed for them for around four hours as God continued to heal many people.

Revival Christian Church - UKRAINE

Elaine and Peter were privileged to return to the Ukraine in May. In response to their visit with the team in March the Church leaders asked Elaine if World Mandate Ministries would assist them with a variety of issues and bring further spiritual support to the Church. Elaine and Peter returned to discuss and pray with the Pastors and church leaders as to the way ahead and the implications of involvement of World Mandate Ministries with the Revival Christian Church.



Whilst there Elaine and Peter met with the Church leadership and had precious fellowship with the pastors and were able to learn their heart for the ministry that God had given them. They also took a laptop computer donated by the team that visited in March, some New Testaments and the Bible on CD was kindly donated by Elim Christian Centre for them to use in their English classes.

Elaine spoke at a leader's seminar at a church in 'Mirnoye' preaching the Gospel at which many came forward to give their lives to Jesus.

God has clearly shown us that as a ministry we are to partner with and support this growing church in the city of Kharkov. World Mandate Ministries will visit the church at least twice a year and bring teaching, support and input on the areas required, as well as preaching the Gospel and taking a team on each occasion. The Ministry will also provide them with teaching material from our Ministry Equipping School to help equip and release the saints into their ministries. We would also support them via email in any other ministerial areas that are needed.

Revival Christian Church also runs 'mercy ministries' to street orphans, in which the local Social Services help them to adopt orphans into Christian families. From 1st June to 31st August the Church is running a summer camp for street orphans, during which time they will be loved, taken care of and shown the love of God. At the end of the camp they will be adopted into Christian families and helped to be rehabilitated so that they can attend school and live a normal life as part of a family that love and care for them



HEALED: Whilst in Ukraine in March this dear lady was miraculously healed of a long term heart condition. Suffering from constant pain and needing strong medication throughout the day. Whilst listening to the teaching on the Holy Spirit she testified that God had touched her. Noticing that her heart did not hurt her any more, she waited to take her tablets later which she was sure she would need. She did not take them as she did not need them. She waited until the next day to "check" whether she had really been healed. Not only did she no longer need her tablets, but the chronic long term pain that she had been experiencing disappeared also. During our visit in May we were told that she had remained healthy and well since that time. We barely recognised her she looked so well.

Ministry Equipping School

The Ministry Equipping School is, as its name implies, a School where the saints are Equipped for Ministry.

In June the Northampton Ministry Equipping School conducted their mission as part of the course and it was a wonderful success. Not only did the Students step out into new and exciting things as God used them, but they also saw fruit for their labours as they worked with the Church in seeing souls saved. They did this in conjunction with Northampton Deliverance Church on Vernon Terrace.

It was an action packed four days which not only challenged the students but released them into the giftings that God had ordained for them. Not only that, souls were added to the kingdom and church members were reignited with a passion for the lost. We thank Pastors Andrew Spencer and Simon Shefford and members of the Northampton Deliverance church for allowing us the privilege of working with them and also for their support and input during the mission. A rich time of fellowship was experienced by all taking part.

The next school commences in October 2006

It was an awesome week with many souls saved, baptised in the Holy Spirit and speaking in new tongues, with miraculous healings and deliverance taking place. The day started at 10.00am and ended about 10.00pm each evening.

The daytime was spent in various ways: - Morning Prayer and ministry, 'Door to door' work visiting the houses in the locality and many contacts were made during the week. In the afternoon there were 'Social Action Projects' ranging from litter picking, painting a children's play area, clearing rubbish and cleaning graffiti from walls.

Every afternoon there was a healing clinic, which the church had organised and which the team took part in, people came in from the community each day to receive prayer for healing. This was so popular that people asked if it could be a regular meeting. The Church has had a vision for some time to run 'healing rooms' this mission saw the birthing and releasing of this ministry. Each evening for seven nights Elaine preached a powerful Gospel message and many people were saved and healed. One beautiful lady was miraculously and wonderfully healed from sixty-seven years of Narcolepsy; her life has been completely transformed as God released her from this life controlling ailment.

It truly was an incredible week in which God blessed and released many people. Three of our team members, Sheila, Sarah and Colette were involved in a wonderful miracle which happened on the streets of Nottingham city centre...



...Sheila tells it in her own words...*Walking home on the Saturday night through the city centre, evangelising on the way, a violent fight broke out a short way from us. We, that's Sarah, Colette and I witnessed a vicious attack in progress. In unison we bound the various spirits of strife and before our very eyes the fight started to disperse and the attacker fled up the street. Two police vans arrived, we pointed them in the direction of the attacker and they made amazing haste and apprehended him.*

We approached the young man who was lying unconscious on the ground. Colette went over laid hands on him and prayed. His condition was serious. He started convulsing violently and blood was pouring from his nose. We held hands and started to pray loudly and interceded for his life before God, asking the Lord not to take him before he had made his peace with Him. We pleaded the blood of Jesus Christ and banged on heavens door. We had our World Mandate Ministries Badges on and Colette was wearing a T-Shirt with Jesus on. About eight police officers surrounded us. They told the crowd to stand back but amazingly and remarkably no one said anything to us. It was a supernatural atmosphere. The three of us continued to pray over the body of the young man, still out cold on the floor. We interceded boldly before the throne of God in the mighty name of Jesus. The police were still pushing everyone back. A friend of the victim tried to make him stand up. We thought, "What is this chap doing, this young man is dying." But, to our complete amazement, the man stood up, with blood coming down his nose and asked what had happened. We could hardly believe that he was able to stand, let alone stand steady and speak coherently.

Colette stood in the circle with the policewoman, the victim and his friend and incredibly still no one asked her to move. It was as though she had every right to be there. The police looked at us but said nothing. This was truly a holy moment. Colette bent over and told the injured man, that three women of God had prayed for him and that Jesus Christ saved his life that night and asked him if he understood, to which he replied, 'Yes'.

This man was fully restored before our very eyes. The ambulance never arrived; Jesus Christ showed up instead and ministered to him on the spot. Glory to God in the Highest, for He is indeed, all powerful, all merciful and the King of Kings. We are in awe at the power of His name, demons fled and a miraculous healing followed.



We have since been informed that news of this incident has spread around the streets of Nottingham like wild fire.

Let God's name be praised.

The purpose of the projects was to let the community know that God still loves the world and that Queensberry Baptist Church loves them and wants to serve them.

Every team member wore a T-shirt which bore this message and which caused much lively and 'divinely appointed' discussion amongst the community.

My name is Michael Down and I, together with my wife Alison are Trustee's of World Mandate Ministries. We have been involved with the ministry since attending the first "Ministry Equipping School" run by Elaine during 2000.

During 2005 I began to suffer from an unusual degree of tiredness and a general lack of energy. We had been travelling abroad doing Gods work and the year was quite busy and I thought this was the reason.

My doctor was worried and sent me to hospital for further investigation which revealed that I had Colon Cancer requiring surgery. I explained to the Doctor that I believed God was in control of my life and that he would see me through this time.

In October I had my operation. By now many people were praying for me and I was at peace knowing that God was in control of EVERY situation.

I was sent home to recuperate but soon received a phone call from the specialist telling me I needed 24 weeks chemotherapy to eradicate any cancer cells that MIGHT be lurking in my system. A shock certainly, but God was (and always is!) in charge so why should I worry.

At a scan following my treatment I was declared clear of any signs of cancer. Praise the Lord!

Thank you to all those people who supported me and my family during this time with prayers, cards, visits and the love of Jesus. I know that God cares and loves us so much and is in CONTROL of our lives as we surrender them to him. Whenever we are up against it for whatever reason lets praise him anyway! That's what my wife and I did, and to HIS Glory – God beat my Cancer.

Praise the Lord Oh my soul and all that is within me PRAISE his holy name.
