Passports, Visas and Vaccinations

Travellers are responsible for ensuring that they have a valid passport for travel to the relevant countries and that it is valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. A visa is required for British passport holders visiting Jordan but not for Israel, details of how to obtain this will be sent with your final invoice. At the time this brochure went to press no vaccinations or inoculations are required for travel but you may wish to consult your own doctor for advice concerning this. If you have

Further Information And Paying The Balance

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 10 weeks before departure.

A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 8 weeks before departure.

Travel Information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Travel Insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices. You can obtain a quote online by visiting www.christian-travel.com or alternatively you can call 0871 360 2742 and quote ABTA number 93522.

Gratuities

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.

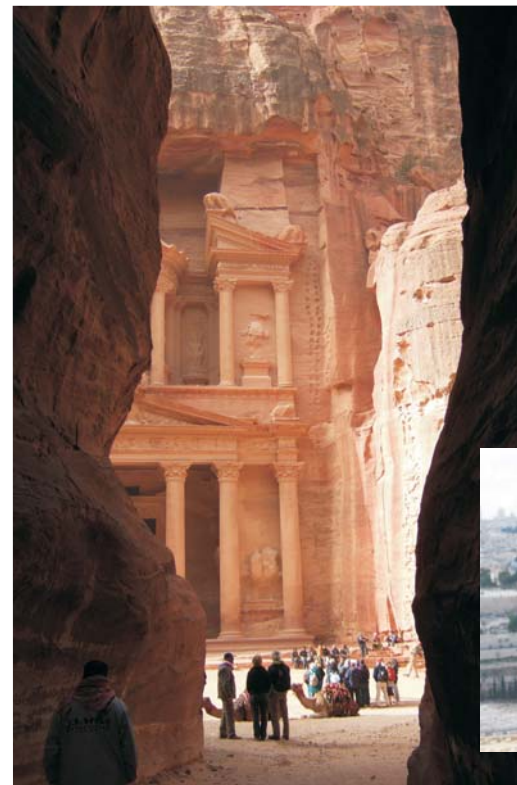

Saturday 29th October

Depart London Heathrow for Amman. On arrival we will be met and then transferred to Petra. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Sunday 30th October

Full day visit to Petra. The Red Rose City of approx. 25 - 30 sq miles carved entirely out of stone in 1st B.C. by Arab tribesmen the Naboteans descendants of Ishmael, Abrahams first born. Made famous by the Indiana Jones Raider films The Last Crusade. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Monday 31st October

Full day visit to Petra. The third most mentioned place in the Bible after Jerusalem and Babylon, believed to be Israel's hiding place during the last half of the Tribulation. Come and walk this land of great history before crossing to Israel. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Tuesday 1st November

Transfer to the Sheikh Hussein Bridge. Visiting Mount Nebo, where Moses viewed the Promised Land but never entered himself and the Baptism site at Bethany beyond the Jordan † en route to Israel. Cross the border and transfer to Tiberius. Dinner and overnight in Tiberius.

Wednesday 2nd November

Today we travel to Caesarea Philippi (Banyas), the source of the River Jordan. We then continue to Megiddo (Armageddon), the site of the last and final battle as described in Revelation. Dinner and overnight in Tiberius.

Thursday 3rd November

Today we visit the home and ministry headquarters of Jesus at Capernaum, the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus often preached and a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight in Tiberius.

Friday 4th November

We leave Tiberius and visit the Baptismal site on the River Jordan at Yardenit. Baptisms can be arranged for believers who have not been baptised. Then onto Bethlehem and to the Church of the Nativity. Driving onto Jerusalem and to the top of the Mount of Olives for view over the Old City and finally the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) the worlds holiest site for Jews and Christians. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Saturday 5th November

Today we visit Mount Zion, The Upper Room, where Jesus had the Last Supper with His disciples and where the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost. We visit King David's Tomb and walk the streets of the Old City of Jerusalem; we then walk

the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane and Church of All Nations, the ancient Pool of Bethesda, the Crusader Church of St. Anne, Eche Homme, Via Dolorosa, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Sunday 6th November

Free day in Jerusalem. To visit church for worship. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Monday 7th November

Today we visit the site of Mount Moriah (Temple Mount). We then meet for a communion service in the Garden Tomb. We visit the Knesset, the Israeli Parliament building or the Supreme Court and then onto Yad Vashem (Holocaust Memorial museum) followed by a visit to the Shrine of the Book - Dead Sea Scrolls Museum. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Tuesday 8th November

Today we travel south to Masada, Herod's magnificent hilltop fortress (accessed by cable car), and the last Jewish stronghold to fall captive to the Romans. Then on to the Dead Sea for a relaxing bathe and mud bath if you wish, followed by a visit to Qumran the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem

Wednesday 9th November

Caesarea Maritima built by Herod the Great, followed by lunch then transfer to Ben Gurion airport for return flight to London Heathrow.
