Day 1 - Tuesday

Fly from London Heathrow to Tel Aviv. On arrival you will be met and transferred to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 2 - Wednesday

Morning visit to Bethlehem, Church of nativity and Shepherds Fields, where the birth of Jesus was foretold. There will be free time to shop in Bethlehem.

Then on to Jericho, one of the world's oldest cities and Mount of Temptation, where Jesus spent 40 days fasting and praying.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 3 - Thursday

We drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for view of Old City and walk the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane, the scene of the agony and 'passion' of Jesus before He was arrested. We then walk the streets of the Old City of Jerusalem visiting the Crusader Church of St. Anne, the Via Dolorosa (the way of the cross) and Dominus Flevit. We visit Caiaphas' house, believed to be the place where Jesus spent His last night before His crucifixion and then meet at Garden tomb for a Communion service.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 4 - Friday

This morning we visit the site of Mount Moriah (Temple Mount) the Davidson Centre (containing impressive archaeological excavations and finds from

the original Temple period) and the Burnt House which dates back to Herod the Great. Then on to King David's Tomb and David's Citadel.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 5 - Saturday

Today we visit the Knesset (the site of Israeli Parliament) Yad Vashem (the Holocaust Memorial Museum) and the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept.

We then go to The City of David which includes a film, Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the cripple and the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) the world's holiest site for Jews and Christians.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - Sunday

Today we leave Jerusalem and travel south to Masada which is Herod's magnificent hilltop fortress (accessed by cable car) and the last Jewish stronghold to fall captive to the Romans. Then on to Qumran, the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, and also to En-Gedi, where Saul hunted down King David and the nature reserve followed by a relaxing bathe in the Dead Sea and a mud bath if you wish.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberius.

Day 7 - Monday

Today we visit Nazareth Old Synagogue, Cana (the site of the first recorded miracle of Jesus) Bethany beyond Jordan, where Jesus was baptized and Chorazin where

Jesus spoke out against the inhabitants unbelief.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberius

Day 8 - Tuesday

We visit the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus often preached and Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus revealed His plans to the Disciples. We then drive up to Mount Carmel and Megiddo (Armageddon), the site of the last and final battle as described in Revelation.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberius.

Day 9 - Wednesday

Today we visit Haifa which is considered to be the place where the prophet Elijah was buried, Capernaum (Jesus' home town) and the Jesus Boat. We also take a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberius.

Day 10 - Thursday

We leave Tiberias and travel to Caesarea Maritime, built by Herod the Great, followed by lunch then transfer to Ben Gurion airport for return flight to London Heathrow.

Or for those taking the extension...

Cross the Allenby Bridge to Amman. On arrival we will be met and transferred to Petra on the way visiting Mount Nebo, where Moses viewed the Promised Land but never entered himself and the Baptism site at Bethany beyond the Jordan. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Day 11 - Friday

Full day visit to Petra. The Red Rose City of approx. 25 - 30 sq miles carved entirely out of stone in 1st B.C. by Arab tribesmen the Naboteans descendants of Ishmael, Abrahams first born. Made famous by the Indiana Jones Raider films The Last Crusade. Dinner and overnight in Petra.

Day 12 - Saturday

Full day visit to Petra. The third most mentioned place in the Bible after Jerusalem and Babylon, believed to be Israel's hiding

place during the last half of the Tribulation. Come and walk this land of great history before crossing to Israel. Transfer to Amman for dinner and overnight.

Day 13 - Sunday

Transfer to the airport for our return flight to London Heathrow.

Passports, Visas and Vaccinations

Travellers are responsible for ensuring that they have a valid passport for travel to the relevant countries and that it is valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. Visas are required for British Passport holders visiting Jordan but not for Israel. Details of how to obtain this will be sent with your final invoice. At the time this brochure went to press no vaccinations or inoculations are required for travel but you may wish to consult your own doctor for advice concerning this. Further Information And Paying The Balance

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 12 weeks before departure.

A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 10 weeks before departure.

Travel Information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Travel Insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices.

Gratuities

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.

Please note that the cost of the tour may be subject to surcharges - please see the booking conditions. Currency exchange rates used £1 = \$1.5685 as published in the Financial Times on 14th March 12.
